front cover quilt

Art Galleryfabrics in Floral Elements and Nature Elements

Michael Miller Jet Black was used as a background fabric

1/3 yard each in pink, turquoise and purple

1/4 yard each in blue, orange, light and mid greys

2 1/2 yards black

Sherbert Kisses Quilt

Benartex Bold and Beautiful fabrics were used in the original quilt

Northcott Stonehenge was used as a background fabric

Centre and corner blocks (Green - 5 blocks) - 2 fat quarters

1st Row (Orange - 4 blocks) - 2 fat quarters

2nd and 3rd Rows (Pink and Yellow - 8 blocks each)

2 fat quarters in pinks 2 fat quarters in yellows

Background 1 3/4 yards

Borders are made from fat quarters

Flowers in the Meadow

Moda fabrics were used

One Layer Cake in Ruby

2 1/2 yards background fabric

A Rogue Block

Moda fabrics were used

One Layer cake in Etchings

1 yard grey background fabric

1 yard cream background fabric

1/2 yard turquoise border

Canadian Pinwheels

Moda fabrics Twirl by Three Sisters was used
Bundle of fat eighth yards
2½ yards black

Batik table runner

1 Timeless Treasures treats (5" squares) in the Pomegranate colour
1 yard cream batik for background. Cut two 11" squares, make two cuts corner to corner to form 4 triangles. Use these as setting triangles for the on-point blocks. The remainder of this fabric is used in the blocks.

Emperor's Garden

Maywood fabrics of the same name
Pinwheels ½ yard each solid black and brown
Fat quarters of all background fabrics (10)
Borders ½ yard

Night Time Fairies

Michael Miller fabrics of the same name
Centre panel
Pinwheels - ¼ yard each of three fabrics
Pinwheel background - ½ yard
Borders - ½ yard (2½" cut)

Carolina Windmills

Uses Grunge fabrics, a basic range from Moda
Border - 1 yard
Background - 1 ¾ yards
Inner border and Pinwheel - 1 yard
10" each of seven pinwheel fabrics

I Love London – not featured in book.

Uses Makower fabrics of the same name
Centre fabric – 18½" square
Red inner border – ¼ yard. Cut two 2" x 21½" strips and two 2" x 18½"
Grey background – one yard. Art gallery Nature's Elements was used
Pinwheels - ¼ yard each of six London fabrics
Cornerstones - ¼ yard
Binding – ½ yard
